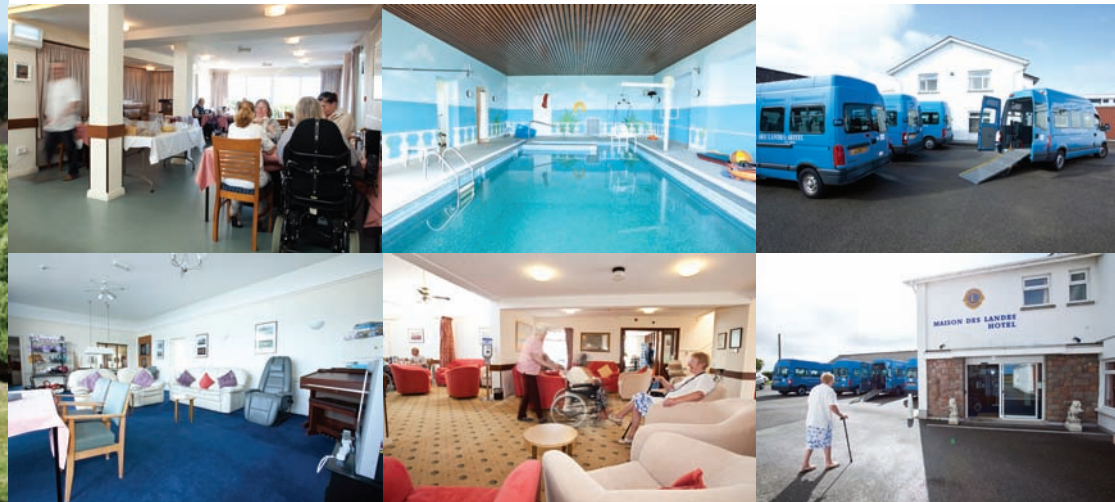
JERSEY – AND A HOLIDAY FULL OF HAPPY MEMORIES

The Hotel caters exclusively for guests with special needs and their carers in purpose-built accommodation specially designed to meet those needs.

The Hotel is situated on a spectacular gorse and heather-covered headland with panoramic views over Jersey's sweeping west coast and the Atlantic Ocean. It caters for up to 49 guests in single, double and family rooms variably suited to their needs.

The Hotel is surrounded by beautiful gardens where guests can enjoy the views and soak up the Jersey sunshine. In the evenings guests have the amenities of a comfortable lounge, perfect for relaxing and enjoying the company of other guests and regular entertainments. The hotel is licensed.



RESERVATIONS

Holidays at Maison des Landes Hotel are offered for 7 and 14 nights but are also available for shorter and longer periods subject to room and travel availability. The Hotel welcomes individuals, couples and families and the tariff includes transfers from airport/port to hotel and return, full board accommodation (breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal), free excursions from the Hotel to places of interest and a full in-house entertainment programme.

Ideally guests with special needs should be accompanied by a carer since the Hotel does not provide as a matter of course in-house nursing or caring facilities. However nursing and specialised facilities are available at extra cost – please enquire for details.

Applications for holidays should be made as early as possible to avoid disappointment. The Hotel welcomes groups and full details and group rates are available from the Management.

The Hotel seeks to be able to accommodate guests with every variety of special need and the Management will be pleased to advise accordingly.

FACILITIES

The Hotel has a large indoor heated swimming pool specially designed with wheelchair ramps and hoists for ease of access and exit. Hotel staff are available to assist guests into and out of the pool and are on the poolside whenever it is in use.

The Hotel provides a wide range of in-house evening entertainment ranging from bingo evenings to karaoke to 'pub' quizzes and visiting entertainers.

During their stay guests can avail themselves of daily sight-seeing tours in specially equipped minibuses (many of which are included in the daily tariff). These tours visit major places of interest, Jersey's magnificent beaches and shopping centres. Tours usually depart mid-morning with stops for morning coffee, lunch and afternoon tea, returning in plenty of time for dinner. Evening tours featuring visits to the theatre, bowling etc. are also available according to demand and availability.
